Utility bill aid extended

Hamilton County families in danger of having their utilities shut off will have an extra month to apply for help from the Community Action Agency's emergency winter home energy assistance program. The CAA is extending the program, which was to end Monday, until April 30. It will also extend its hours of operation to accommodate appointments. Families face disconnection of services unless they pay for the 90 days of service received during a statewide moratorium that ended March 18. Residents of Hamilton County with a family income at or below 175 percent of the federal poverty guidelines and who face disconnection are eligible for assistance.
