Financial Assistance Available to Help Families Stay Warm this Winter *Winter Crisis Program available at 12 locations throughout Hamilton County*

What: The Cincinnati-Hamilton County Community Action Agency (CAA) is providing up to \$175 in financial utility bill assistance through its Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP).

When: November 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011
Walk-ins are accepted Monday – Friday beginning at 8:00 a.m.

Who: Hamilton County households that have been disconnected, have received a disconnection notice or have less than a 25% supply of bulk fuel, and earn a household income less than 200% per the federal poverty guidelines (\$44,100/yr for a family of four).

Why: Keeping gas and electric service on is a necessity. However, many families simply cannot afford to do so and must turn to the Community Action Agency for help. Especially in this difficult economy, many people are turning to CAA who have never asked for this type of assistance before.
