

Citirama breaks ground June 1

The 10th Citirama, an urban home show, breaks ground tomorrow.

The groundbreaking ceremony will take place at 10 a.m., June 1 at the corner of Rhode Island Avenue and Faith Street in Bond Hill.

Located in the Villages of Daybreak, this year's Citirama will feature homes from Brookstone Homes, Perry Bush Building Group, **The Drees Co.**, **Maronda Homes**, and **Potterhill Homes**. There are 196 single-family homes and 102 condominiums in the Villages of Daybreak, developed by Allen Temple-Tryed Stone Development.

In addition to the groundbreaking for the development, a new partnership between Blueprint for Success and the National Association of Home Builders will be announced. The new partnership pairs students in the construction trades with various builders.

Two of the five show homes have already sold. Prices for the show homes will range from the mid to upper \$200,000s.

Citirama is a sister show to the Home Builders Association of Greater Cincinnati's Homearama event. The Citirama home show generally features smaller homes in the \$200,000 to \$250,000 price range in urban communities. It is co-sponsored by the HBA of Greater Cincinnati and the city of Cincinnati.

Last year's Citirama was the most success ever.

Mayor **Mark Mallory**, other city officials, HBA of Greater Cincinnati President **Rex Gordon**, and **Robert Nielsen**, chairman of the National Association of Home Builders will participate in the groundbreaking.
