Even though spring is here, are you still trying to pay off those winter heating bills?

- What:** The Cincinnati-Hamilton County Community Action Agency's (CAA) Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) helps families pay utility bills if they have been disconnected, have received a disconnection notice, or have less than a 25% supply of bulk fuel. However, time is running out. CAA will only be giving out \$175 in utility bill payment assistance for 5 more days. The agency's winter emergency program will end on Wednesday, March 31.
- Who:** To be eligible, Hamilton County residents must earn a household income at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines (\$44,100/year for a family of four). Other eligibility criteria apply.
- When:** Walk-ins are accepted Monday through Friday at 8:00 a.m. Appointments are not available.
- Where:** Cincinnati-Hamilton County Community Action Agency

- Why:** Many families are struggling in this difficult economy. Winter heating bills were so expensive, many families still have unpaid balances threatening to result in disconnection. CAA's HEAP program may be able to provide the assistance so many families desperately need. However, funds are limited, so families should apply as soon as possible.
