### Ohio's Home Relief Grant

**Rent, Mortgage, Water & Sewer Assistance**

# OHIO'S HOME RELIEF GRANT

Ohioans who are behind on their rent, mortgage, water, and/or sewer payments may be eligible for assistance through the Coronavirus Relief Fund made available by the CARES Act.

CAA may be able to assist households:

- Facing eviction or late notice from their landlord;
- Are homeless or experiencing imminent homelessness;
- Mortgage delinquency or forbearance unable to pay their mortgage and have verification of past due payment;
- Threat of disconnection of water and sewer, utility, rental arrears, mortgage delinquencies and past due amounts from April 1, 2020 may be paid.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Households at or below 200% FPL and who have been impacted by COVID-19.

2/members \$34,480  
3/members \$43,400  
4/members \$52,400  
5/members \$61,360  
6/members \$70,320  
7/members \$79,280  
8/members \$88,240

- ✓ Grants can cover up to 3 months
- ✓ For families with low to moderate incomes (80% of Area Median income) Ex. Family of 4 annual income is at or below \$69,050.

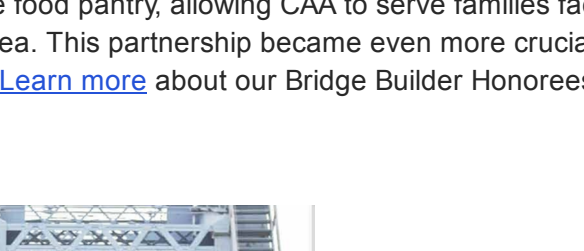

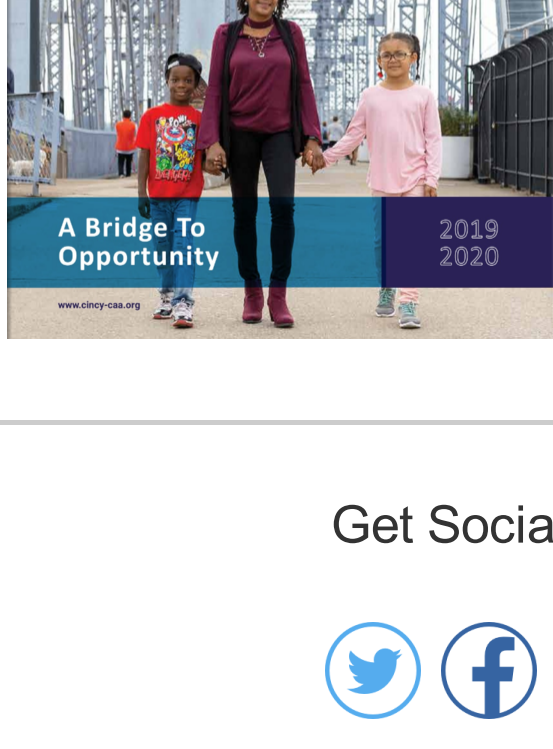
### 56th Annual Luncheon

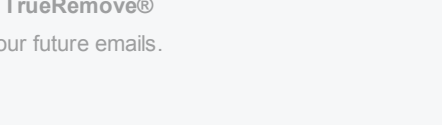

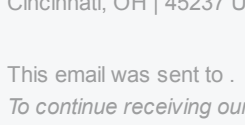
