Ohio's Home Relief Grant

Rent, Mortgage, Water & Sewer Assistance

OHIO'S HOME RELIEF GRA

Ohioans who are behind on their rent, mortgage, water, and/or sewer payments may be eligible for assistance through the Coronavirus Relief Fund made available by the CARES Act.

CAA may be able to assist households:

- Facing eviction or late notice from their landlord; Are homeless or experiencing imminent
- homelessness;
- Mortgage delinquency or forbearance unable to pay their mortgage and have verification of past due payment;
- Threat of disconnection of water and sewer, utility, rental arrears, mortgage delinquencies and past due amounts from April 1, 2020 may be paid.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Households at or below 200% FPL and who have been impacted by COVID-19.
