HOW IT WORKS

The Women of Color in Tech partners offer free 12-week training programs to prepare women for roles in cybersecurity, data analytics, digital marketing & e-commerce, IT support, project management, and UX design. The programs are designed to meet participants where they are with flexible, virtual and in-person options – as well as childcare. Once complete, partners will facilitate employer interviews tailored to each participant to help them secure a job that best fits their new skillset, personal needs, and career aspirations.

- Virtual, in-person, or hybrid class options
- Additional resources like financial and career coaching, resumé creation, and mock interviewing
- Graduation celebration and a Google badge to display on LinkedIn and resumé
- Interview opportunities with employers hiring people with these skills and certifications
