We have entered into our Summer Crisis at CAA, which means that we have begun to provide relief to Hamilton County residents, needing assistance with their electric service through September 1st. The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) is offering up to \$500 in aid towards customers' electric bill. Those who qualify are also eligible for a new air conditioner or a fan. Staff at CAA are taking appointments daily to make sure we continue to meet the needs of our clients.

Over the last few days, there has been a spike in the number of COVID-19 cases. Please remember to be safe as we still have a long way to go before this pandemic is over. This is a difficult time for us all. Again, I want to encourage everyone to continue to stay safe and keep others safe by wearing protective face coverings, practicing social distancing, and staying at home as much as possible.
