The Community Action Agency's Home Relief Program is now assisting Hamilton County residents with rent, mortgage, utilities, water and sewage.

Qualifications Include:

- Facing eviction or late notice from landlord.
- Qualified for unemployment 2020/21 or reduction in household income due to COVID-19. Experiencing imminent homelessness or are in
- jeopardy of missing a future payment.
- Mortgage delinquency or forbearance unable to pay their mortgage and have verification of past due payment.
- Threatened with disconnection of water and sewer, utility, rental arrears, mortgage delinquencies and past due amounts from April 1, 2020.
- Direct or indirect COVID-19 hardship.




