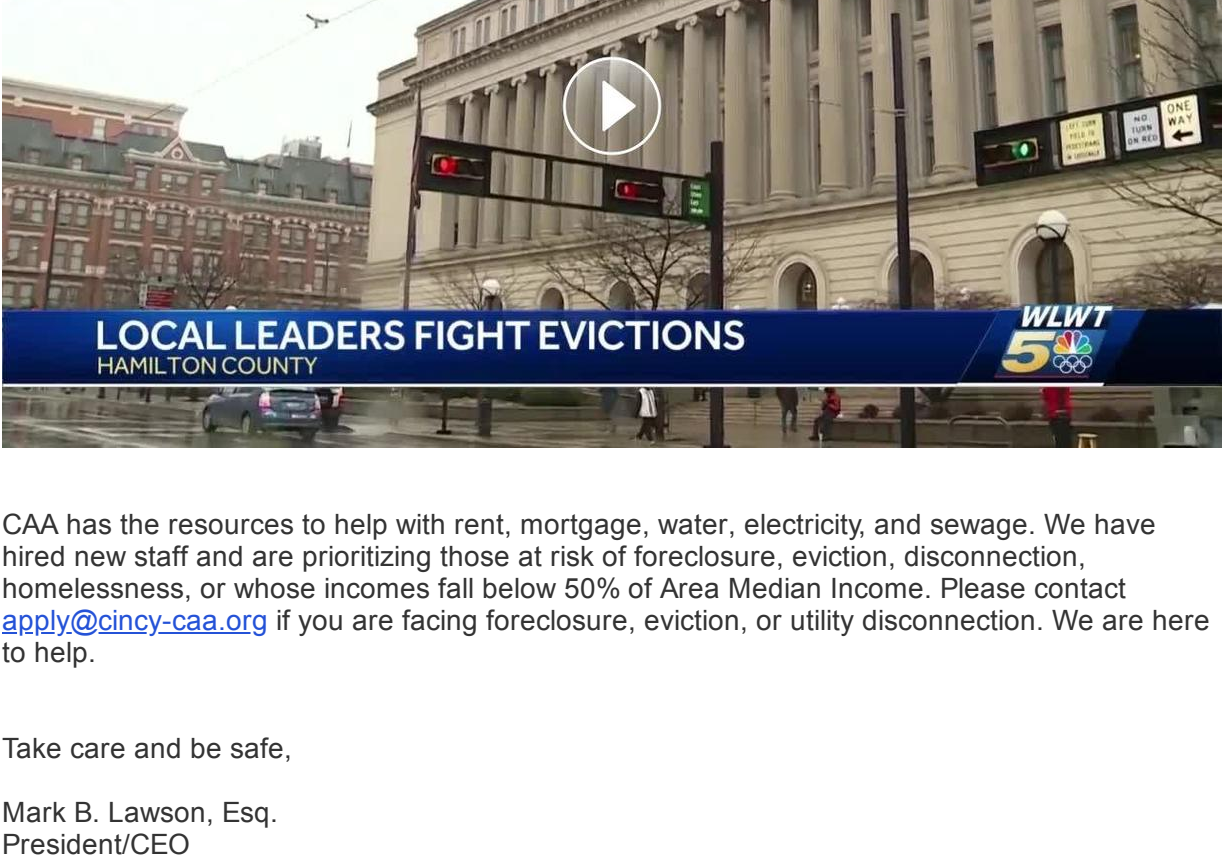




Hello Friend,

Now is the wrong time to evict people. I stood on the steps of City Hall with City and Hamilton County leaders and asked the City to enact its own moratorium for City residents facing eviction for nonpayment of rent. I also stressed the importance of enacting a "pay to stay" ordinance, which would prevent eviction for nonpayment of rent when the tenant has the money or a pending application with an agency providing rental assistance.



CAA has the resources to help with rent, mortgage, water, electricity, and sewage. We have hired new staff and are prioritizing those at risk of foreclosure, eviction, disconnection, homelessness, or whose incomes fall below 50% of Area Median Income. **The Community Action Agency's Home Relief Program is now assisting Hamilton County residents with rent, mortgage, utilities, water and sewage.**

**All households, including immigrants, qualify for assistance. Qualifications Include:**

- Unable to make payments on rent, mortgage, water and/or utilities.
- Threatened with homelessness or disconnection of water and sewer, utility, rental arrears, mortgage delinquencies and past due amounts from March 13, 2021.
- Qualified for unemployment 2020/21or experienced a reduction in household income, related directly or indirectly, to COVID-19.
- At or below 80% AMI (Area Median Income), based on 12 month's income or 30 days.

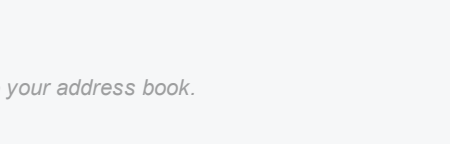

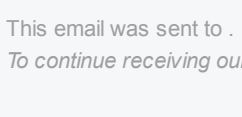
